

In order to keep the pump market competitive the District will allow the use of the Zoeller Progressive Cavity Grinder Pump Model E810 or the E-One Pump Model DH071. The District would like to clarify that, although Zoeller pumps may be somewhat cheaper, this style of Zoeller pump is a relatively new pump on the Zoeller market and does not have a proven track record as the E-One pump.

With low pressure systems being a relatively new way to service neighborhoods throughout the District your feedback on the project is welcome. As one would expect, the District is interested in feedback about the project as a whole but is also interested to hear the quotes you have receive from contractors for doing your final installation. This information will help us update our reference database for estimating costs and allow us to inform future customers of trends we see in the marketplace.
