Subject: Springmill Streams Low Pressure Sewer Project

Dear Property Owner:

The Clay Township Regional Waste District awarded Atlas Excavating, Inc. the construction contract for the Springmill Streams Low Pressure Sewer Project. The earliest we anticipate construction starting is the week of December 14th. The contractor will have one hundred and twenty (120) calendar days to complete the work.

Since this project is being directionally drilled, there should be minimal disruption during construction. If for some reason access to a driveway has to be restricted, the residents will be given prior notice. Typically, the contractor will give residents 24 hour notice if their driveway will be blocked for an extended period. If you have any special access needs, please call Ryan Hartman, the District Engineer, at 844-9200 and specify what is required to facilitate those needs.

Please be prepared within the next few weeks to inform the District's Inspector, Mr. Shawn Pabst, where you would like your lateral stub placed along your frontage. If you have problems determining where to place the lateral, please contact our office to request an onsite meeting with Shawn or contact a plumber to determine where your plumbing exits the home. If property owners are not able to be contacted prior to construction, the District will determine the location of the lateral.

Once the sewer is constructed and has passed all testing, a connection notice will be sent to let you know that you may now connect to the sewer and payment of the construction costs are due. If you wish to defer your connection to the sewer, please refer to the attached deferral policy. Please note the main line construction costs must be paid within 90 days even if connection to the sewer is deferred. The main line construction costs can be financed through the District over 5, 10, or 20 years. Since you will contract directly with your contractor to install your lateral and pump, this cost can not be financed through the District.

Thank you in advance for your understanding and patience during construction and we look forward to servicing you in the near future.
