Re: Springmill Streams Sanitary Sewer Project

Dear Springmill Streams Resident:

In the next few days you will be seeing survey crews from Weihe Engineers collecting topographic points and utility locations in order to make a recommendation for the location of the proposed sewer. This is still a preliminary but essential step in determining if sewers can be installed without purchasing easements which could ultimately increase the overall cost of the project. Once the preliminary design is complete, a public meeting will be held to explain the proposed project and get feedback from residents. The proposed project will then be presented to the Board of Trustees for a first reading of the Rate Ordinance. If the first reading is held, the Board will then hold a public hearing at the following month's Board meeting at which anyone that wishes to speak about the proposed project may do so in front of the full Board. After the second reading of the ordinance, the Board will decide whether or not to approve the project.

A map of the results of the survey is shown here. As of May 13<sup>th</sup>, the response cards were tallied at: 30 not interested, 27 interested, and 18 that did not respond.
